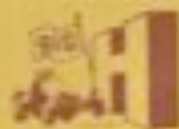

Indianapolis Auto Racing

Comes To The San Joaquin Valley

The roar of the rear-engine speed demons will be heard in California for the first time today as the top drivers whiz over the rebuilt one-and-a-half mile Hanford Speedway track in the "California 200", the longest race of its type to be held in California in 30 years.

Speed will be the keynote today as those drivers who have tested the Hanford track say it is build for records.

A. J. Foyt and Art Pollard hit speeds over 150 an hour—up to a record 154.68—in tire testing and they were not extending their cars as they would in a hotly contested race.

The two speedsters and Bill Vukovich consistently were under 36 seconds a lap in zooming around the Hanford track. Each came away from tire testing with forecasts speeds in the big 200 will soar above 155 miles an hour.

There are plenty of top names on hand today. Besides Foyt and Pollard the list includes such famous-name veterans as Mario Andretti, Gordon Johncock, Roger McCluskey, Bob and Al Unser, Joe Leonard, Jim McElreath, Chuck Hulse, Carl Williams, Bud Tinglestad, Larry Dickson, Mel Kenyon, Ronnie Duman, Johnny Rutherford, George Snider, Al Miller, and Lloyd Ruby.

Rookies, in addition to Vukovich, will include Gary Bettenhausen, Jim Malloy, and Bruce Walkup.

They will race for a \$20,000 guaranteed purse against 40 per cent of the gate, boosting it up to the ranks of the highest purses offered for this type of race in California. The first-place winner will zip off with 25 per cent of the purse—a sizeable chunk of money.

One of the highlights of the big race will be the duel between the Ford V8s and the Super-Charged Offenhausers. The Ford motor has muscled the fore in Indy racing but there are those who say the Offy takes to the Hanford track like the proverbial duck does to water.

"The way this track is laid out," Foyt says, "I feel the turbo-powered Offy will be faster than my Ford V8."

"On most tracks those turbo-powered jobs can pull us on the straight but our Fords are better at the intermediate speeds and in cornering.

"Here at Hanford the turns are about as fast as the straights and the Fords will be able to hang with the Offies all the way.

"So look out."

Not all of the attention today will be on the speed duel out on the track. The STP beauty in which Parnelli Jones almost won this year's Indianapolis 500 will be on display. But once the racing gets under way all else will be forgotten as fans will be watching the fastest racing in the West this year.

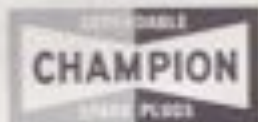
