"California 200"

Indianapolis Auto Racing
Returns To The
San Joaquin Valley

High-speed driving returns to the San Joaquin Valley as the big, rear-engine racers open the nation's 1968 championship battle with the California 200 in Hanford.

Last year more than 20,000 fans turned out for the first J. C. Agajanian-sponsored 200 and witnessed a thrilling race that was not decided until the final few laps when Gordon Johncock of Hastings, Mich., was able to come through with the record.

Johncock will be back this year to defend his title. But there will be a change. He will be driving a Turbo-Charged offenhauser while last year he drove a Ford V8.

He is not the only one switching to the Offy. Such drivers as Bobby Unser and Bill Vukovich have made the switch. Enough drivers switched so that there may be more Offies than Fords on the track ---the opposite was true last year.

That will setup a duel to determine which is the better motor, not only for the Hanford track but possibly also for the Memorial Day 500 in Indianapolis. Several drivers are testing the engine(suspension and a few other items) in this race for possible use at the Big One.

The fuel problem looms big in the drivers' minds. All are gambling on going all the way on one load of fuel--about 70 gallons. That means a lot of careful driving as well as dare-devil gambling for them to make it without a refueling stop.

Tires will offer no problem. Tire companies have developed them so that they can take the 200-mile grind easily. The only stops for tire checks will be the mandator ones after a car spins--a required check to see if the spin scraped any flat spots on the tires.

Speeds should be above last year's. Not only do the driver's have the experience of the first race behind them but they also have tuned up their cars better. Speeds of over 150 miles an hour were common in tire testing, the highest being over 157 m.p.h.

The drivers rate the Hanford track second to Indy's. But, they feel, the fans get a better deal in Hanford as the cars tend to stay bunched while the cars string out at Indy.

Bunched or not, all are planning to start charging from the outset and keep "lead-footing" it all the way, figuring there is no other way to win.

Racing will be hot and fast from start to finish.

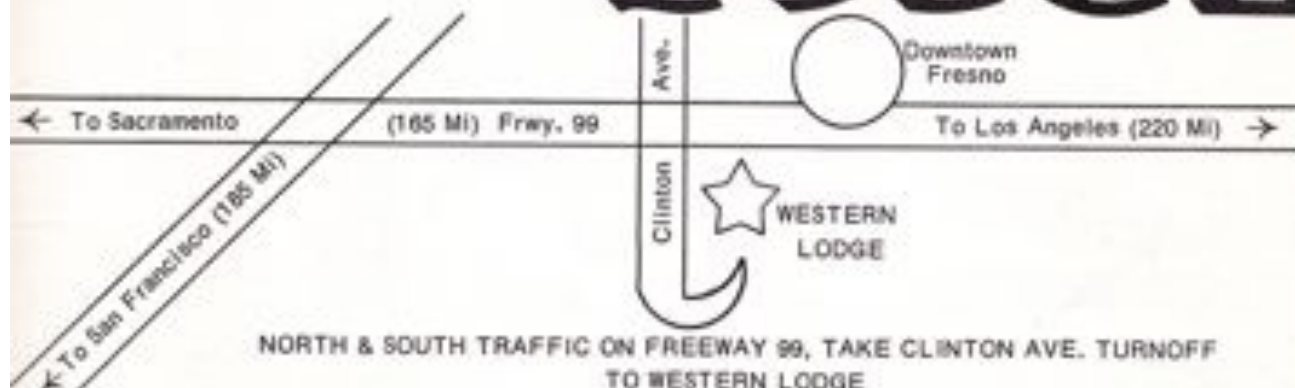

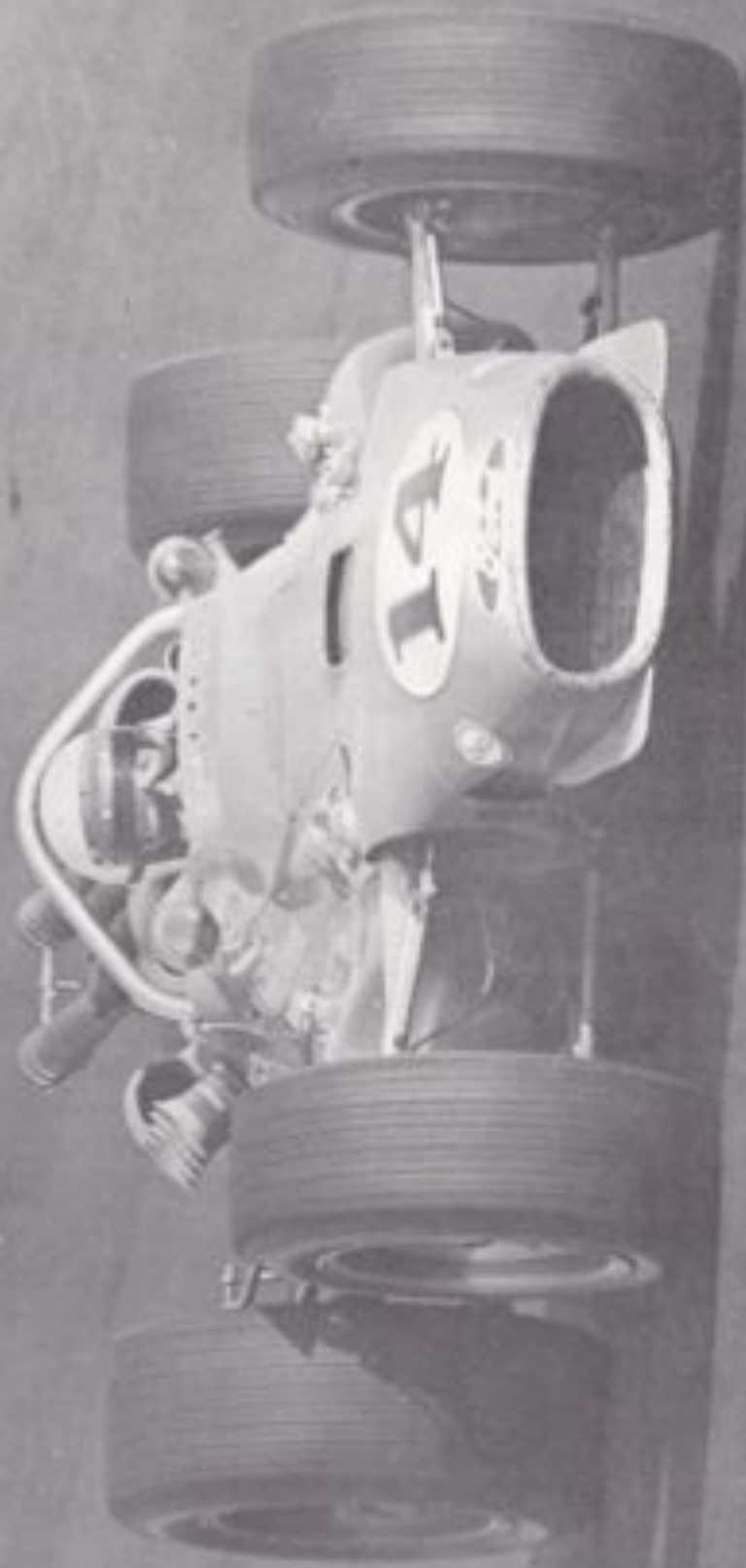

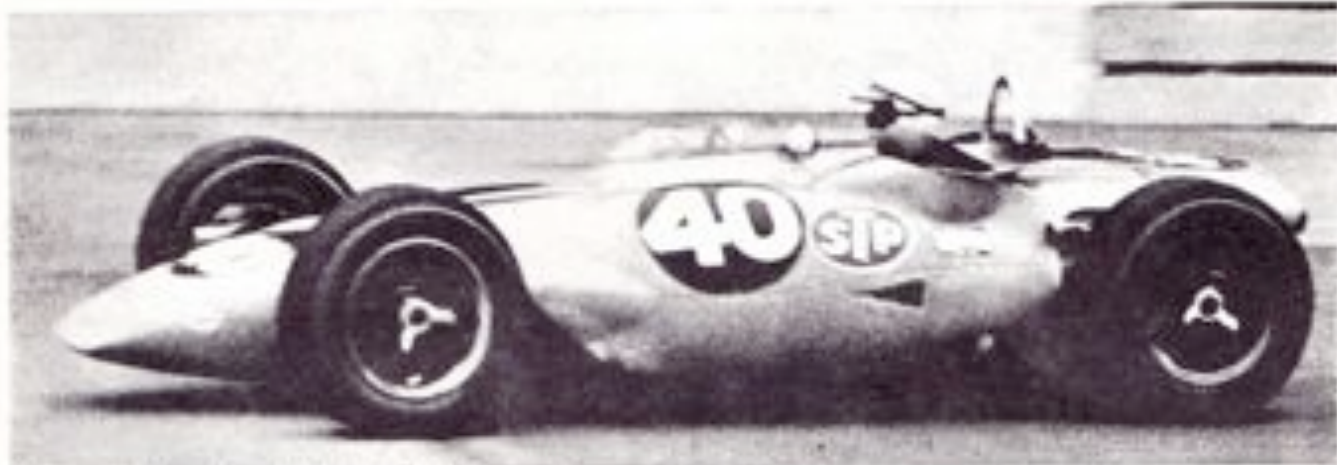
